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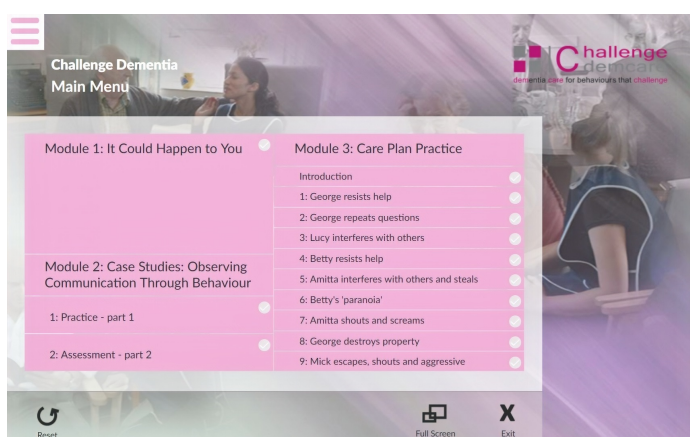

This is a free, interactive 'real life' course specifically for staff working with 'challenging behaviour' in dementia, arising from an NIHR Applied Research Programme. New treatment pathways were updated in 2019. Module 3 (level 2) consists of 9 evidence-based, real-life interactive video-based case studies of graded complexity.

It assists practitioners to:

- Detect the causes of 'behaviours that challenge' caregivers
- Make rational decisions on individualised unmet health and psychosocial needs
- Offer personalised health and psychosocial 'behaviour' support plans
- Recognise what care home staff and family carers may themselves require to manage health and psychosocial 'behaviour support plans' - and when to seek additional professional expertise
